Frequently Asked Questions about the Center

How much does it cost to work with the Center?

What entities can apply to work with the Center?

For intensive engagement, either the Title V or the CYSHCN program from a state/territory can apply, or the programs can apply together to work on a project of interest to both.

When is the next opportunity to work intensively with the Center?

The next cohort of intensive states will work with the Center from March 2015 through January 2016. The Requests for Proposals will be released via Transformation Station and the Center's website on December 1, 2014. Applications will be due in mid-February.

On January 28, 2015, the Center will host a Day of Learning for up to two representatives from each state/jurisdiction interested in exploring work with the Center. The Day of Learning will be held immediately following the AMCHP annual conference in Washington DC.
